

Durbin Creek Elementary's VPK selection is done by a lottery system. 2024-2025 school year VPK Lottery applications will be accepted January 8, 2024—January 31, 2024. The first week of February, 12 applicants will be selected and notified. Upon acceptance, those selected students will begin the registration process.

Only students selected will be contacted. If you have not been contacted by February 15th, then your child was NOT selected for one of the 12 spots, and will be put on the waiting list. Due to the number of lottery applications, it is advised that you have a back-up plan. Other VPK providers can be found at Search (myflfamilies.com)

POLICIES AND PROCEDURES

The St. Johns County School District (SJCSD) VPK Program is a high-quality early childhood program for four-year-olds. The SJCSD VPK Program consists of the first three hours free with wrap-around services for a full school day on a sliding fee scale. The fees are based on your Free or Reduced Meal status.

Fees for SJCSD VPK wrap-around service:

☐ If your family is eligible for <i>Free Meals</i> – No Parent Fee (Free)
☐ If your family is eligible for <i>Reduced Meals</i> - \$133 per month
\square If your family is not eligible for Free or Reduced Meals - \$475 per month

The VPK program at Durbin Creek Elementary is a <u>full day</u> PreK program (same hours as KG-5). The student must be 4 years old on or before September 1, 2024, to apply.

There is a fee for this full day program; **\$475per month** if not eligible for free or reduced meals. **\$133 per month** if eligible for reduced meals. **Free** if eligible for free meals. Due to limited space, acceptance is based on a lottery system.

VPK Lottery applications will be accepted January 8th, through January 31st, 2023. Due to the limited space, it is recommended that you apply to other schools in the area, as well. Final selections will be made by February 9, 2024. Only those accepted into the program will be notified with instructions on how to proceed.
